1. Terms and conditions:
 - 1.1. **Promoter:** The Promotion is conducted by West Suffolk College, Out Risbygate, Bury St Edmunds, IP33 3RL, United Kingdom ("we", "us", "our").
 - 1.2. **Promotion Period:** The competition is open between 00.01 on 01 August 2022 and 23.59 pm on 31st August 2022. The winners will be announced on week commencing 5th September 2022. Notification will be made via email.
 - 1.3. **Eligibility:** In order to claim your prize or participation certificate, you must complete and submit the Choose Hospitality – Junior chef Competition form. You must be resident in The UK and aged ten (10) to fifteen (15) years old on the date the competition opens. ("you", "your(s)") are eligible to participate in the Promotion and, by participating in the Promotion, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions (which may be amended or varied at any time by us).
 - 1.4. **Promotion:** The overall value of the prize is £250 per individual winner (10 winners in total). The prizes are non-transferable and may not be exchanged for cash or other services. - 2.4. The winners will each receive a fully funded 8-week Junior Chef Cookery Course, delivered at West Suffolk College.

 - c) 08/10/22 - Week 3 - Seasonal Fruit Pie and Custard
 - d) 15/10/22 - Week 4 - Chicken Tikka and Salad
 - e) 21/10/22 - Week 5 - Teriyaki Salmon on Egg Noodles, Stir Fried Vegetables
 - f) 05/11/22 - Week 6 - Chocolate Brownies and Vanilla Ice-Cream
 - g) 12/11/22 - Week 7 - Chocolates and fudge
 - h) 19/11/22 - Week 8 - Students to cook and serve a two-course lunch for parents and family or invited guests - maximum of 4 covers in total
