

Fashion and Textiles Level 3





Welcome to UAL Level 3 Extended Diploma in Creative Practice: Fashion and Textiles.

This exciting course is designed to give you the essential skills and knowledge to enter the world of fashion communication. You will learn: Conceptual Design, Research skills, Fashion Design, Fashion Styling, Print for fashion and textiles, Stitch for fashion and textiles, 3D for fashion and textiles, Dyeing and coloration, Creative pattern cutting, Technical pattern cutting and Digital design for fashion and textiles.

All these skills will accumulate into an independent Final Major Project at the end of each year, displayed in our School of Art and Design exhibition. Within this course we work with you individually to find your passion within the fashion and textile industry and work with you to achieve your goals.

Preparing to start your course

You will need to buy your KIT list packs in the college shop on your first day It includes:

-Plastic A3 carry case -A3 hardback sketchbook -Scissors -Fine liner 0.5 -Pencil -Rubber -sharpener -Glue stick -Double sided tape -Graphite stick -Charcoal pencil -Pack of sewing needles

You will also need:


- Lever Arch File for pattern cutting & Plastic File (poly) pockets
- **Personal Sewing kit (for pattern cutting sessions):** dressmaking scissors, embroidery scissors, pins, material tape measure, coloured thread
- General art kit (for workshop sessions):- Ruler, paintbrushes, paper scissors, craft knife, masking tape
- USB Memory Stick (min. 32GB) or USB External Hard Drive (Usually 500GB+)
- Extras (not requirements as these are available at college, but it would benefit your studies to use them within your independent study time): A laptop or computer to support the software we use (Adobe CC is available as part of your student enrolment)

Enrichment fee: You will be required to pay an enrichment fee of £40 (TBC) for trips and specialist materials. There will be a range of relevant trips offered throughout the year, relating to the course. These are a considerable strength of our provision and excellent learning experiences. There will also be some additional costs for some materials and outcomes that you produce as you progress through the course.





Independent study time: You will be required to be in college three days a week and to complete two days' worth of coursework from home. Your timetabled college days will be confirmed when your place on the course is confirmed, upon receipt of your results.







Summer Work Task

Summer project: ORIGINS: EXPLORING YOUR IDENTITY

Your summer task is to find, collect, and document objects, images, and articles that you find interesting and that are related to YOU, this can include the everyday but also think outside of this, this mini-summer task is a prelude to your main project 'ORIGINS: EXPLORING YOUR IDENTITY' so make whatever you produce count as you will be taking your colours, pattern, images, texture, drawings and ideas into your first project.

A total of 20 pages minimum will be needed in your A5 sketchbook or notebook.

you will document your interests, events and experiences by collecting and producing things such as:

- Drawings pencil, paint, ink, etc -can be very quick and rough and can be long studies.
- · Doodles
- · Photographs
- · Bits of magazine articles
- · Bits of newspaper articles
- Your thoughts and writing
- Song lyrics
- Event tickets or memorabilia (that will find you your sketchbook!)
- Fashion drawings
- · Bits of fabric and textiles

The list is limitless: anything which you find interesting enough to put into your A5 sketchbook; you can work on the page by writing or by doodling and drawing.

You will be using your A5 sketchbook on your first day so it is essential you complete this task.
