Summer Project Task


Site Plan Scale Drawing

Those that attended the taster day will have a set of measurements and levels and be creating a scale drawing of the field corners on the A3 paper that was issued. You are to use a scale of 1:200 and if you are unsure how to do this you should research scale drawing on U Tube.

Students that did not attend on the taster day should produce a scale drawing of the site at 1:200 using the dimensions on the below site plan sketch.

You should also confirm what the scale of the attached drawing is.

You can do this using a normal ruler if you say that the scale is 1:100 i.e 1 cm = 1m then at 1:200 1cm = 2m. But a scale rule would make this easier. This is an important skill but have fun as you do it one day someone might be paying you to do this.
