In 2022, the total contribution of travel and tourism to the UK's GDP rose to an estimated 237.1 billion British pounds.

In 2023, the UK welcomed 38.0m inbound visits

Overall, travel and tourism generated, directly and indirectly, around 330 million jobs worldwide in 2023. This figure was predicted to reach an estimated 348 million in 2024, surpassing pre-pandemic levels.

- working patterns for each of the job roles.

Travel agents Tour operators Airlines and airports Accommodation providers Visitor attractions Passenger transport operators Tourism development

Task Two

Next, focusing on **one industry**, produce a brief **report** on why different working patterns apply to different roles, giving examples. You should cover full-time, part-time, seasonal and shiftwork. The report should have the following structure:

Introduction

An overview of the industry that you're going to focus on, try and include things such as:

How many people are employed in this industry, how much money does this industry make the UK each year, who are some the main companies which operate in this industry?

As an example:

This report is going to focus on the accommodation industry, this industry generates.... some of the biggest employers in the accommodation industry are as follows.....

Who in your chosen industry might be employed in a full-time role? As example a hotel manager

Who in your chosen industry might be employed in a part-time role? As an example hotel receptionist

Who in your chosen industry might be employed in a seasonal contract? As an example an events assistant

Who in your chosen industry might be employed in a shiftwork role? As an example waiter or waitress
