Who is this course suitable for?

Anyone looking to begin a career in the Construction Industry.

What can I expect to learn?

You will learn all about Health and Safety in a Construction Environment including hazards, COSHH, PPE, manual handling and understanding the precautions to take when working on a building site.

How long is the course

The course runs for 3 days, from 9.30am to 1.30pm daily.

How and where do I study?

Courses are delivered face to face, in the classroom, at one of our professional learning centres.

Are there any exams or assessments?

There are 2 assessments during the course.

The first is taken at the end of day 2 which is an online Level 1 Health & Safety in a Construction Environment.

The second is taken at the end of day 3 which is the CSCS test which is conducted at an external test centre close to the place of study.

Will I achieve a qualification or certificate?

You will achieve a City and Guilds Level 1 certificate in Health & Safety in a Construction Environment and your CSCS card at Operative level.

Are there any costs?

Yes, employers are required to pay 20% contribution towards the costs of this course which is £55.00. The course is FREE for unemployed individuals.
