Who is this course suitable for?

These courses are for people who are starting out, or changing to, a career in environment or sustainability focused roles. It's the progression route from IEMA Level 2 courses. This course will prepare you with everything you need to know to start your journey. This course is also great for people working in other professions, such as marketing or finance, to gain a basic understanding of sustainability that you might apply in your role. This course leads to Associate membership of IEMA, the professional body for sustainability professionals, which is covered by the course fee for one year following passing the assessment.

There is no doubt that sustainability is becoming an increasingly significant and urgent issue for businesses and similar organisations. Individuals who understand it and can provide advice on how to improve organisational impacts, are in short supply.

What can I expect to learn?

By the end of this certified IEMA Foundation Certificate in Environmental Sustainability course, delegates will be able to:

- Outline the implications of global trends for the environment, for society, for the economy and for organisations.
- Outline sustainable business/governance principles and their relationship with organisations, products and services.
- Outline environmental principles and their relationship with organisations, products and services.
- Outline major policy and legislation and their implications for organisations, products and services.
- Outline major tools, techniques, systems and practices used to improve sustainability performance.
- Outline the role of innovation and other leading practices in developing sustainable products and services and providing sustainable solutions.
- Collect data, perform analysis, and evaluate information.
- Research and plan to provide sustainable solutions.
- Deliver effective communication and capture feedback.
- Engage with stakeholders.
- Outline tools and techniques that identify opportunities and risks.
- Identify and propose ways to improve performance.
- Support change and transformation to improve sustainability.

How long is the course?

The course runs one day per week, for five weeks, approx. 40 hours.

How and where do I study?

Courses are delivered face to face, in the classroom, at one of our professional learning centres.

Are there any exams or assessments?

There is a 60-minute, multiple-choice assessment.
