L2 Certificate in Welding Skills

Who is this course suitable for?

The Level 2 course is ideal for students who are already working in welding and fabrication industries and are looking to develop skill further to increase responsibilities and knowledge. Students will need to hold at least a Level 1 in Welding Skills to apply and will be subject to interview and weld test prior to acceptance on the course.

What can I expect to learn?

To achieve the Level 2 Certificate in Welding Skills learners must achieve a minimum of 14 credits from the following:

- L2 Award in Manual Metal Arc (MMA) Welding 7 credits
- L2 Award in Tungsten Inert Gas (TIG) Welding 7 credits
- L2 Award in Metal Inert Gas (MIG) Welding 7 credits
- How long is the course?

1 evening a week over 20 weeks.

How and where do I study?

This course is delivered at West Suffolk College.

Are there any exams or assessments?

For each qualification candidates will be required to complete 5 practical assignments and one oral knowledge test for each welding unit.

Will I achieve a qualification or certificate?

Yes, successful completion of all assessments will lead to achieving L2 Certificate in Welding.

Are there any costs?

Yes, employers are required to pay 20% contribution towards the costs of this course. Course fee is £250
